REGULATIONS made by the Minister responsible for transport in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 112 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chapter 230 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020, and all other powers thereunto him enabling.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the

**MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC
(AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2024,**

and shall be read and construed as one with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Regulations, which, as amended, are hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 2 by inserting the following term and its corresponding definition in its proper alphabetical sequence—

Amendment of
regulation 2.

““electric omnibus” means a public service vehicle, other than one licensed as a freight passenger vehicle or as a taxi, that uses electric power as its means of propulsion;”.

3. The principal Regulations are amended in Schedule R, in Form 3, by inserting after paragraph (c) the following new paragraph—

Amendment of
Schedule R.

“(ca) A fare of \$3.00 for passengers travelling on an electric omnibus to any destination within the boundaries of Belize City.”.

Expiration of
Regulations.

4. These Regulations cease to be in force and expires on the 31st day of December, 2025.

Commencement.

5. These Regulations shall come into force with effect from the 19th day of July, 2024.

Negative
resolution.

6. These Regulations are subject to negative resolution.
