ORDER made by the Minister responsible for the National Protected Areas System in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 33(2)(b)of the National Protected Areas System Act, Chapter 215 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020, and all other powers thereunto him enabling.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the

WILDLIFE SANCTUARY DECLARATION (SPANISH CREEK) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2024,

and shall be read and construed as one with the Wildlife Sanctuary Declaration (Spanish Creek) Order, which is hereinafter referred to as the principal Order.

2. The Schedule of the principal Order is repealed and replaced with the following-

"SCHEDULE [paragraph 2]

SPANISH CREEK WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land in the Belize District comprising of approximately 5703.9 acres of land bounded on the north-north west by the community of Ranch Dolores, on the east by Sarah Humes Estate on the South by Labouring Creek and on the west by portion of Rolling Creek Works and Programme for Belize and hereinafter described as follows - Sub. Leg, 2020 Edn. CAP 215

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Citation,

Repeal and replacement of Schedule. Commencing at a point west of Rancho Dolores Bridge and along the south side of the Rancho Dolores Road having scale UTM co-ordinates of 1939 544.4 North and 327 800.2 East;

Thence southeast along the south side of Rancho Dolores Road for an approximate distance of 113.2 meters to a point having scaled UTM co-ordinates of 1939 490.4 North and 327 899.7 East;

Thence southwest ascending the eastern banks of Spanish Creek for a distance of 481.538 meters to a point having UTM co-ordinates of 1939 101.026 North and 327 616.535 East;

Thence continue southwest ascending the eastern banks of Spanish Creek for a distance of 201.0 meters to a point having UTM co-ordinates of 1938943.543 North and 3274 91.603 East;

Thence continue southwest ascending the eastern banks of Spanish Creek for a distance of 762.636 meters to a point having UTM co-ordinates of 1938 322.129 North and 327 049.496 East;

Thence southeast for a distance of 835.493 meters to a point having UTM co-ordinates of 1937 754.583 North and 327 662.635 East ;

Thence south for an approximate distance of 1,505.9 meters to a point having scaled UTM co-ordinates of 1936 731.5 North and 328 767.8 East ;

Thence south for an approximate distance of 1,795.8 meters to a point along a 40 feet wide road reserve having scaled UTM co-ordinates of 1934 935.7 North and 328 759.6 East;

Thence west for an approximate distance of 1,202.0 meters along the north side of the 40 feet wide road reserve to a

point having scaled UTM co-ordinates of 1934 932.5 North and 327 557.6 East;

Thence south-west for a distance of 646.762 meters to a point having UTM co-ordinates of 1934 295.405 North and 327 446 .762 East;

Thence continue south-west for an approximate distance of 3,626.9 meters to the confluent of the Belize River and Labouring Creek and having scaled UTM co-ordinates of 1930 716.3 North and 326 859.0 East;

Thence generally west ascending the northern bank of Labouring Creek for a distance of approximately 7,346.9 meters to a point having scaled UTM coordinates of 1930 759.1 North and 323 705.1 East;

Thence north-west for an approximate distance of 2,540.3 meters to a point having scaled UTM co-ordinates of 1933 210.0 North and 323 037.0 East ;

Thence north-east for an approximate distance of 1,516.3 meters to a point having scaled UTM co-ordinates of 1934 292.8 North and 324 098.5 East ;

Thence north for an approximate distance of 96.8 meters to a point along the western bank of Spanish Creek having scaled UTM co-ordinates of 1934 389.5 North and 324 102.3 East;

Thence descending the west banks of Spanish Creek for a distance approximately 7,072.7 meters back to the point of commencement.".
